



PARENT REFUNDS POLICY

PURPOSE

The School Council has the responsibility to ensure there is a fair and equitable refund system in place following payment for Camps/Excursions/Incursions and to ensure parents provide information to the School in a timely manner.

The aim of School Council in monitoring the Refunds:

- Ensure Parents/Guardians are made aware of school charges in a timely manner
- Ensure Parents/Guardians inform the school of changes to circumstances re the attendance of Camps/Excursions in a timely manner
- Ensure opportunity is available for all students who take part in the camps and excursion programs, whilst also ensuring the program is conducted on a financial viable basis
- Provide guidelines and outline circumstances in determining eligibility for a full or part refund for charges paid to the school by families.

GUIDELINES

- Parent requests for refunds are subject to the discretion of the school and are approved on a case-by-case basis. Refunds will be provided where the school deems it is reasonable and fair to do so, taking into consideration whether a cost has been incurred, the Department's [Parent Payment Policy and Guidance](#), Financial Help for Families Policy and any other relevant information.
- A request for a refund does not automatically mean a full refund of monies paid.

IMPLEMENTATION

EDUCATION ITEMS

Refunds are not available for payments made for Education Items that are retained by the students (e.g. stationery)

CAMPS/EXCURSIONS/INCURSIONS

Participation of students in an activity is indicated by completing permission and payment in Compass.

1. Students withdrawing from an activity will not automatically be entitled to a refund. This will be determined by any expenses incurred by the school and the reason for not attending.
2. Deposits for Camps will be non-refundable. Requests for this to be refunded must be in writing and the Principal will determine the final outcome.

REVIEW PERIOD
